Developmental reading, writing, and mathematics course prerequisites can also be attained through placement testing. ** Mandatory Math Placement - All incoming students will be required to provide ACT scores or take a placement test and based on their scores, students will be placed in appropriate mathematics courses. Successful completion (C- or better) of any math course is required in order to advance to the next higher level math course.

~ Prior to graduation, all students entering after Summer 2008, must receive credit for MATH 0074 Introduction to Algebra, or any math course above MATH 0074 or an ACCUPLACER Elementary Algebra ≥58 **and** College Level Math ≥20 or COMPASS Algebra ≥31, or ACT Math ≥21.

^ Placement in WRIT 0090 or higher; students placed in READ 0080 cannot enroll in HUMA1010 until they have completed their reading course.
